

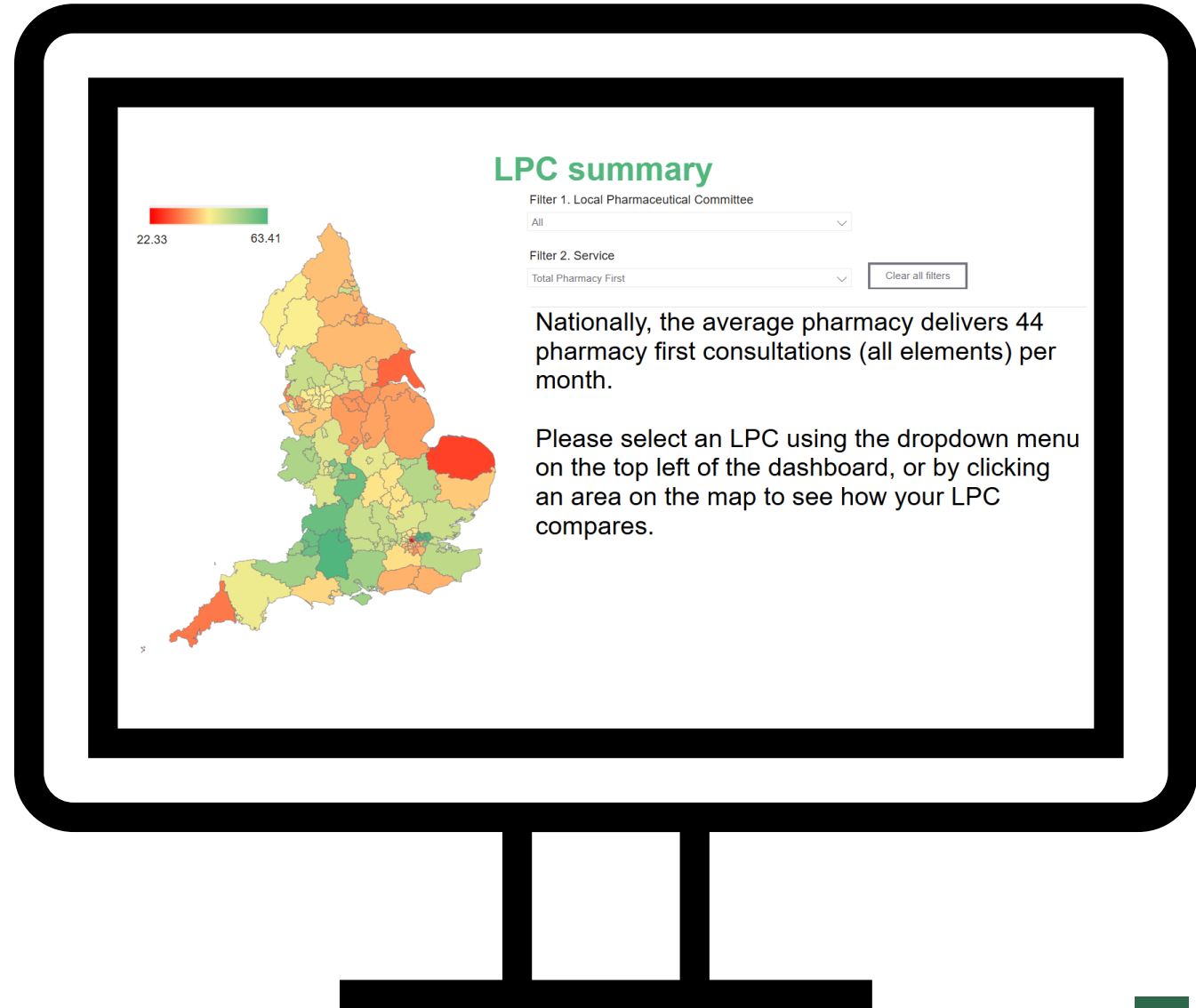


Local Data Dashboard

*An interactive data dashboard to support Local
Pharmaceutical Committees and their contractors*

What is it?

- The Local Data Dashboard will provide LPCs with the latest overview of contractor performance across their geography.
- This interactive dashboard allows LPCs to understand activity volumes across all essential and advanced NHS services, allowing them to target their support to their contractors.



What does it do?

- The dashboard provides an overview of activity at both LPC and contractor level and allows for benchmarking against other LPCs across the country.
- This allows LPCs to provide support to contractors to:
 - Maximise NHS income
 - Make decisions about where to target additional investment (financial or people) to increase service capacity and meet patient demand.



How does it do this?

1. Comparisons between LPCs:

- The dashboard shows comparisons between LPC service activity, both regionally and nationally, for individual national services. This allows LPCs to benchmark themselves against others and identify services which are underperforming compared to their peers.

2. Data to support negotiations:

- Allows you to view data to support negotiations, customised to whatever you wish to see. This includes linking other data sets published by the NHS or the Government, including deprivation data, type of pharmacy, distance selling vs bricks and mortar etc.

3. Contractor support:

- The dashboard allows a review of individual pharmacies. You can compare individual service activity for that pharmacy compared to other pharmacies nationally and within the LPC.
- Alternatively, the dashboard allows comparison of service activity within pharmacy owners. Individual pharmacies may be compared to other pharmacies with the same owner, both within their LPC and nationally.

Single user: £350 per year



Up to 3 users: £450 per year



Up to 15 users: £700 per year

- Data is sourced primarily from the NHS Business Services' Authority.
- Data is available 3-months in arrears.
- Data starts January 2020 and will be updated the first week of the month.
- Future developments are planned to further increase functionality.
